President Bob Schwab opened the hearing for the continuation of the Instructional Support Program at 5:38 p.m.

Board Secretary Neil Mills read the Resolution of intent.

The Board of Directors of the Columbus Community School District in the County of Louisa, State of Iowa, does hereby resolve to participate in the Instructional Support Program for a period of five (5) years, to levy annually, as determined by the Board, an instructional support property tax which will be levied annually upon the taxable property within the District, commencing with the levy of property taxes for collection in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and an instructional support income surtax imposed annually for each budget year, the percent of income surtax (not to exceed twenty percent (20%)) to be determined annually by the Board for each budget year to be imposed upon the state

individual income tax of each individual income taxpayer resident in the District on December 31, 2022, and each year thereafter.

The funds thus collected, when combined with Instructional Support State Aid shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of the regular program district cost, including the budget adjustment pursuant to Iowa Code section 257.14 for any budget year. Instructional Support Program funds may be used for any general fund purpose.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board deems it necessary and desirable to continue to provide additional funding for the Columbus Community School District generated by participation in an Instructional Support Program; and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to take action to adopt a Resolution to continue to participate in an Instructional Support Program;
